**PUBLIC WELCOME AT STATE BOARD OF INVESTMENT MEETING**  
**--ATTEND IN-PERSON OR ANYWHERE THROUGH FIRST-EVER AUDIO CONFERENCING--**

PHOENIX, AZ – Arizona Treasurer Eileen I. Klein is inviting the public to attend the State Board of Investment (BOI) meeting on Thursday, December 27, at the Treasury Office. Those who can't attend in-person can [listen](#) to the meeting from anywhere online or by phone. This is the first time the Arizona State Treasury is offering remote audio monitoring of a BOI meeting. The monthly meeting reports on investment activity, anticipated impacts on revenues, and future market conditions.

The meeting will provide detailed presentations on November investment performance, earnings distributions, and operating balances for the Land Endowment (for schools), and money invested for state agencies and local governments. The Treasurer's Report will include a presentation on the Treasury's just-released '[stress tests](#)' on cash flow and the Endowment. This will also be the final BOI meeting of Treasurer Klein's tenure. Her last day in office is January 7, 2019. Treasurer-elect Kimberly Yee, who will be sworn-in on that day, is also scheduled to attend this month's meeting.

"It has been an honor to serve as Arizona's State Treasurer and I look forward to using our new remote audio program to share some of our important 2018 accomplishments with even more people at this month's meeting," Treasurer Klein said.
